Public consultation stage on the proposed 6 substances of very high concern

04 September 2018, Member States of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), propose 6 substances to be identified as SVHCs. Deadline for commenting is 19 October 2018. All interested parties are invited to submit comments during the public consultation. When the public consultation ended, if the 6 substances were accepted, there will be 197 substances listed on the SVHCs. The 6 proposed substances are listed below:

According to REACH, if SVHC is present in products in a concentration that greater than 0.1% and the volume for export is less than 1 tonne, downstream importers shall be notified with such information for communication and also provided with certifications. However, if SVHC is present in products in a concentration that greater than 0.1% and the volume for export is greater than 1 tonne, notification of such information to ECHA is necessary.
