## Attention: The EU has officially added PFHxS to the POPs regulation

On August 8, 2023, the European Commission published a revised regulation (EU) 2023/1608 of the EU POPs Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 in its official gazette, officially listing PFHxS, its salts, and related substances on the list of prohibited substances in Annex I of the EU POPs Regulation. This regulation will come into effect on the 20th day after its publication in the official gazette. At this point, the list of prohibited substances in Annex I of the EU POPs regulation has been increased from 28 to 29.

In Part A of Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, the following entry is added:
